GUIDELINES FOR CSB CANDIDATES -2015

1. **Aim** To test the level of knowledge of the candidate in History and assess his/her suitability for employment as PGT/TGT in Army Public Schools which are **English** medium Private schools following the **CBSE** syllabus.
2. **Knowledge Level** It is expected that the candidate must be a Graduate/ Post Graduate in the subject for which she/he is applying. The candidate must have thorough knowledge of the Graduation/ Post Graduation level in the subject.
3. **Understanding** Candidate should have an in-depth knowledge of Historical events and processes. The candidate should be able to understand, comprehend and analyze a question and choose the most relevant answer from the multiple options given in English within the limited time available.
4. **Awareness** The candidate should be aware of the latest developments in the relevant subject, the latest changes introduced by CBSE in the school curriculum and the developments in the field of teaching and learning.
5. **Structure of the paper-** Questions would be based on
 - (a) Knowledge
 - (b) Understanding
 - (c) Application
 - (d) Higher Order Thinking Skills
